LOANED EXECUTIVE PROGRAM

United Way's Loaned Executive Program provides local leaders with an opportunity to represent their company as a champion of change within our community. Selected applicants will learn about our community's most pressing issues and the critical needs facing our ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Restrained, Employed) population. These leaders will join United Way's fundraising efforts to help move the needle across our region for those who need it most.

What is the time commitment of a Loaned Executive?

The Loaned Executive program will kick off with a one-day training on May 20, 2026 and will run through April 2027. Loaned Executives will be asked to commit between 5-8 hours monthly of service to the United Way, with 5 hours being the minimum requirement.
